- JTC 01 "Implementation of CIE 191:2010 Mesopic Photometry in Outdoor Lighting"
- (S. Mucklejohn) Meeting in Jeju. TN 007:2017 published with interim
- recommendations, TR still under heavy discussions.
- JTC 08 "Terminology in Light and Lighting" (N. Parry) At final stage, publication of
- new ILV awaited in mid 2018.
- JTC 11 "Light and Lighting Maintenance Factor Way of Working" (N. Parry) –
- Meeting in Jeju discussing and commenting the WD2 draft. Plan to publish TS
- (Technical Specification) in mid 2018.

Reporterships

- **R 4-49** "Flicker from Lighting on High Speed Road" (C. H. Wen) Reporter present at the meeting gave brief information on the progress. In further to check and decide whether to keep this reportership or to integrate with the currently established joint research forum on "Temporal Light Modulation".
- **R 4-50** "Document Status Joint with DIV5" (D. Gasparovsky) Reporting is under agenda point 16. This reportership naturally needs collaboration of a group of experts. DMT to consult with CB if to turn this reportership into a research forum or other appropriate structural entity.
- **R 5-12** "Lighting and ECO Systems" (S. Davis) DD to check the status and progress with reporter. To consult and avoid conflict with R 5-17 and with ToR of the reviving TC 5-27.

- **R 5-16** "Photometric Specification and Measurement of Sports Lighting Installations" (A. Smith) After previous reporter T. Lemons retired, reportership was discontinued. Upon current reporter's request, D4 agreed to close it.
- **R 5-17** "Environmental Impact Assessments" (M. M. Taylor) DD to check the status and progress with reporter. To compare the scope with ToR of the reviving TC 5-27.
- **R 5-18** "Comparison of Glare Assessment Methods" (S. Volker) To be closed upon reporter's request. Approved by D4.

- **04** "Visibility Design for Roadway Lighting" revival of TC 4-36. TCC Giuseppe Rossi (IT)
- 05 "300 mm Roundel signals" is revival of TC 4-46 TCC Ron Gibbons (US)
- **06** "Guide for Floodlighting" is to revise CIE94-1993. TCC Diana del Negro (PT or GB)
- 07 "Guide for prevention of lighting pollution caused by colour light and dynamic lighting to residential buildings".
